1 • BOOKINGS

- 1.1 - Booking forms must be returned, signed by a duly authorised person, before February 28th 2008, with a cheque corresponding to the booking fee and 50% of the total amount including VAT. See the booking form. Cheques to be made out to: Pôle 2iFB.
- 1.2 - On reception of the deposit, a full invoice will be despatched, to be paid in full before February 28 2008, by cheque made out to: Pôle 2iFB. Before this date, cancellations are possible, but the deposit and booking fee will not be reimbursed.
- 1.3 - After this date, unless agreed otherwise by the organisers, all amounts invoiced are due, and the stand or site will be allocated as the organiser sees fit.
- 1.4 - Any stand or site remaining unoccupied on Thursday April 17 2008 at 6pm will be allocated or dismantled without compensation.
- 1.5 - All the exhibitors/companies present must have paid booking fees.

2 • PRODUCTS AND SERVICES EXHIBITED

- Only products and services with a relationship to waterways are accepted at Pâques Boat.
- 2.2 - Exhibitors may only present equipment, products and services listed in the booking form and accepted by the organiser.
 - 2.3 - The same product may only be sold by several exhibitors with the written agreement of the manufacturer.
 - 2.4 - The distribution and sale of "takeaway" products must respect current legislation and be with the organisers' agreement.
 - 2.5 - The preparation, distribution and sale of perishable goods and food are subject to current legislation and under the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.

3 • SITE – ASSEMBLY & DISMANTLING – OPENING TIMES

- 3.1 - The organisers are free to allocate and modify sites at any moment.
- 3.2 - Installation will only be possible once the exhibitor or authorised person has signed the appropriate papers at Reception.
- 3.3 - Stands may only be assembled on April 17 2008 from 9am to 7pm.
- 3.4 - Exhibitors' vehicles may under no circumstances use security access passages during unloading.
- 3.5 - Vehicles must have left the show ground and be on the car parks by Friday April 18 at 9am.
- 3.6 - Electrical structures and installations may under no circumstances be modified by the exhibitor.
- 3.7 - Stands may not be dismantled or emptied, even partially, before Sunday April 20 2008 at 7pm. Dismantling must be completed by Monday April 20 at midday.
- 3.8 - Structures supplied must be returned free of adhesives, inscriptions, posters, ropes, etc. It is expressly forbidden to staple or drill canvas coverings or structures.
- 3.9 - In the case of early delivery of exhibits, please clearly indicate on parcels the number of your stand/site and the company name.

4 • IN-WATER BERTHS – LAUNCHING CRAFT

- 4.1 - Craft in the water must be equipped with moorings, fenders and gangways that meet current legislation.
- 4.2 - Launching of boats by slipway takes place on the Saône, followed by a lock.
- 4.3 - Craning of vessels of a maximum of 15 tonnes will take place on Thursday April 17 by appointment. Trailers and trucks must return to the car park once they have unloaded. Vessels must immediately make their way to their allocated berth. The organisers reserve their right to come on board and to move cumbersome vessels.
- 4.4 - Exhibitors are allocated 1.20m of quayside by their vessel for advertising and reception of visitors.
- 4.5 - Vessels moored at an angle may not extend over 15m from the quayside to the channel.

5 • SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 5.1 - In line with the new safety regulations, the Organisation Committee employs a security manager and two security assistants, from the beginning of assembly to the completion of dismantling. These three people are entrusted with enforcing the regulations and specifications provided to each exhibitor and that the latter has agreed to respect.

- ON-LAND SAFETY

- 5.2 - Stands, including decoration and contents must meet safety norms, both in terms of the equipment, as well as the fixing and assembly systems. The organisers and the security staff reserve the right to forbid the use of any non-conform equipment, and even to request the dismantling of stands considered dangerous, without compensation.
- 5.3 - The shrouds of stands and any other overhanging or prominent features must neither hamper nor present a risk to the public.
- 5.4 - Devices and engines whose operation may create a risk or a nuisance must be equipped with effective protective devices. The organisers may demand that they be stopped if deemed necessary without appeal.
- 5.5 - Heavy objects must be correctly wedged and anchored.
- 5.6 - Inflammable or toxic products are expressly forbidden within the show grounds, with the exception of those inside integral tanks of crafts, devices and engines or in their original unopened packaging. Stands exhibiting inflammable goods must so inform the security manager and foresee the presence of one or several fire extinguishers.
- 5.7 - Security access passages must under no circumstances be obstructed.

- IN-WATER SAFETY

- 5.8 - Craft and vessels must be equipped with navigation licences, according to all current legislation, insured and captained by persons equipped with necessary licence.
- 5.9 - Those in charge of craft are solely responsible for any accidents caused by the craft or those transported.

6 • SECURITY - INSURANCE

- 6.1 - Security within the show grounds will be entrusted to an authorised company from 8pm to 8am from Thursday April 17 2008 in the evening up until Monday 21 April 2008 in the morning. Vehicles, trailers and vessels must be locked, stands must be covered by canvas. Outside of the above caretaking hours, equipment and products are the sole responsibility of the exhibitor, who undertakes to provide proof of public liability insurance with the membership form. Each exhibitor MUST take out FULL COVERAGE for all goods within the exhibition grounds.n.
- 6.2 - Only local residents and those accommodated in the grounds, after presenting themselves in advance to the organisation who will grant them a nominative badge, will be EXCEPTIONALLY authorised to enter the site outside opening times and on condition that they carry both the badge and proof of identity.

7 • GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 7.1 - Exhibitors may under no circumstances extend their installations beyond the limits of their site or encroach on passageways.
- 7.2 - Banners and displays must not hamper the sight of stands. Advertising off the stand is not allowed, unless authorised by the organisers.
- 7.3 - Audio and video installations, engines and other equipment that generate sound are subject to approval by the organisers and must not hamper neighbouring stands.
- 7.4 - The prospection, sale or distribution of leaflets or advertising off the stand is not permitted.

8 • WATER-FARING REGULATIONS

- 8.1 - Exhibitors who wish to carry out demonstrations do so under their own responsibility and must have obtained the prior approval of the organisation. Times and routes will be established by the organisers, which the exhibitor undertakes to scrupulously respect. Vessels may only navigate with sonar authorisation, and must regain their berth within the allotted time or run the risk of exclusion.
- 8.2 - The maximum speed authorised for all engine-powered craft is 6km/hr.
- 8.3 - Inland water navigation rules and regulations must be respected at all times.
- 8.4 - Areas will be set aside for events, sports demonstrations and craft and will be out of bounds to other vessels.
